We are very excited to announce the launch of our mobile farm taking our wonderful farm animals into the community for Educational and Therapy visits.

Our mobile farm brings the sights, sounds and experiences of the farmyard to your County Show, corporate event, school, nursery or residential home.

We provide a hands-on, educational and tactile experience for children and adults of all ages. Our visits provide the opportunity to learn about our farm animals, how to care for them and where our food comes from. Visits provide the opportunity to meet farm animals and real farmers, sometimes for the first time.

Our educational visits are very popular with primary schools and inparticular Early Years and Key Stage 1 as they fit perfectly within the Curriculum.

For our Therapy visits we concentrate on sensory experiences, encouraging conversations, and increasing mobility from activities such as brushing, feeding and petting.



Our Mobile Farm is a valuable tool in helping us connect the wider community with farming practices and helps to support British farming.

Our visits are tailored to your needs and one of our experienced staff members will discuss the aims and outcomes of your visit prior to your booking. Our most popular visits include:

- Time for visitors to meet, groom and feed our animals;
- Answering questions regarding breeds and their differences, what each animal eats, where they live and sleep and how we care for our farm animals;
- Why farmers rear lambs and goats?
- How the weather and seasons affect farming;
- Display of equipment such as ear tags and sheep drench guns and explanation of why they are used.

Our prices are based on the individual event and requirements but as a guide the following prices apply:

1 hr £185 + VAT 2 hrs £275 + VAT 3 hrs £400 + VAT 4 hrs £550 + VAT



Please note: if your event is more than 10 miles away from us we do charge extra for fuel - the additional charge will be confirmed at the time of booking.

For 4hr events, our animals will require a 30 min break during our visit. Risk assessments are provided prior to bookings and all staff have been DBS checked.
